

The Voluntary after the Service this morning on the 175th anniversary of the Dedication of Christ Church will be the Coronation Anthem (Zadok the Priest), no, XX of the adaptations for organ by John Marsh of Airs and Chorusses by G.F.Handel. Marsh (1752-1828) was organist at Chichester and played in Worthing; although he would not have known Christ Church, it is possible that his Voluntaries were still in print in 1843.



create a cathedral-like gallery of stunning multi-coloured glass on Worthing Pier in Sussex that represents local societies, people and projects. There are literally hundreds of windows so once complete it will be quite a spectacle and something Worthing can be proud of!

The pier is actually in the parish of Christ Church, and the PCC have agreed to pay for a window to be erected for Christ Church. An artist who specialises in stained glass has been commissioned to produce some sample pictures, so you, the congregation, and the PCC can choose what we finally ask to be placed on the pier.
