The pianist Yoko Ono is much in demand as a soloist, chamber musician and teacher in the UK. She studied at the Royal Academy of Music where she won prizes and scholarships including the Leverhulme Postgraduate Studentship. Yoko has performed in major venues including the Wigmore Hall, Purcell Room and Barbican as well as many music festivals. She has made a concert tour in China, given numerous recitals and concerto appearances in Japan and performed at the National Concert Hall in Dublin with the guitarist Paul Gregory. Her performances in other countries include France, Italy, Israel, Cyprus, Switzerland and USA. She has made recordings of chamber music for Claudio Records and DKlassiscs. She enjoys playing a wide range of repertoire including works by Sussex composers. In July 2022, she will be performing in the Vendsyssel Festival with the clarinettist Steve Dummer in Denmark.

Now based in Brighton, Yoko is a committee member of the Lunchtime Concerts at the Chapel Royal in Brighton and teaches at the Royal College of Music Junior Department in London.
